

Guidelines for Group Representative (GR) Terms

The "Area Structure Changes" breakout group discussion at the June 2014 Area Assembly focused on the length of term for the Group Representatives. The majority of those participating favored a one year renewable to up to 3 year term. At the conclusion of the discussion, the AWSC was asked to prepare suggested guidelines for new terms of office for Rhode Island Group Representatives and to present them to the GRs for their vote at the December 6, 2014 Area Assembly:

"The Group Representative and Alternate Group Representative are elected by the group for a one-year term that is renewable up to 3 years. Each group may choose its own method of electing its Group Representative and Alternate Group Representative."
